



Sporting Success For Wiggin

Wiggin scores a win with two assistants selected to play for London Lawyers in the Lawyers World Cup.

Wiggin, the media law firm, has enjoyed a sporting success with the selection of two of its assistants to play for London Lawyers in the Lawyers World Cup. This makes Wiggin the only firm with 2 players in the squad. Both Ciaran Hickey and Chris Hammond will be playing in the tournament in June 2008.

The Lawyers World Cup (or Mundiavocat) in Alicante runs between 30th May and 8th June. The Mundiavocat is held every 2 years and approximately 50 teams will be entering the 2008 tournament. Teams come from countries across 5 continents including, Thailand, Iran, Argentina, Brazil, China, Ivory Coast, Canada, South Korea and Japan. Europe is widely represented with some teams enjoying semi-professional players and major sponsorship from organisations such as Pirelli.

London Lawyers are the only English representatives in the tournament and will be taking a squad of 16, made up of players from predominantly city firms. Wiggin's Ciaran Hickey was part of the London Lawyers team that won the Lawyers European championship in Portugal 2007.

London has never won the Lawyers World Cup but following their European tournament success last year, the team are hopeful that at least one England football team will be successful this summer!
